## **CCTU Annual Educational Bursary**

### **About the bursary**

This award is designed to support the professional development of Non Consultant Hospital Doctors (NCHDs) who are committed to training in Medical Oncology and Haematology and is open to Specialist Registrars, Registrars, SHOs and Interns. The bursary will be awarded to the successful applicant who has identified and committed to a 3<sup>rd</sup> level post graduate course relating to cancer or to attend an educational meeting with a view to presenting research.

### **What is the value of the bursary?**

The maximum award that can be applied for is €5,000.

### **When will the bursary be awarded?**

The closing date for the submission of applications is 31<sup>st</sup> May each year. Awards can be made retrospectively for the preceding calendar year. The successful applicant will be notified in June each year.
